- **Questions and Answers**
  - Would speakers integrated into the LCD be okay to substitute for the USB powered speakers line item?
    - **Yes, speakers integrated into the LCD would suffice as a substitute**
  - Resistors noted are 0.6mm leads. Could you confirm this is supposed to be 6.0mm leads?
    - **6mm leads are what was intended. As long as the leads allow for the resistors to be easily used in a breadboard, we should be fine.**

  - Do all items need to be prepackaged in the carrying case or do all components need to fit within the case?
    - **Prepackaged in carrying case is preferred so that we can immediately start distribution.**
  - Is the August 1 delivery date firm?
    - **Our school term starts early September and we would definitely need them before then. So, August 1<sup>st</sup> is a little flexible i.e. +/- 3 weeks.**
