- Work area SGB-8SS main chamber (interior appx.) o~96<sup>11</sup>x 27" x 30<sup>11</sup>L x D x H (inches)
- Overall (includes 36" stand and filtration housings, appx.)

# Pass-Through Airlock

The Class III BSC/glovebox shall be equipped with a 3-door pass-through airlock (left side, if facing). Door 1 opens into the Class III BSC, door 2 opens into the lab space and door 3 opens into the Class II BSC. The pass-through airlock will have a PLC controlled interlock **system** so only one door can be open at a time.

- · Airlock interior dimensions:
  - ~16W" x 16D" x 16H"
- Airlock includes passive HEPA filtration

Airlock doors are PLC controlled and electro-mechanically interlocked

## Primary and Secondary HEPA ONLY Filtration System

HEPA filter housings on Class III Biological Safety Cabinets (BSCs) must be leak-free and designed to allow certifiers to scan test filters to validate that they are also leak free. Per the BMBL, Class III BSCs require double HEPA filtration on all exhaust air, provisions must be made to check the integrity of each exhaust HEPA filter individually. Germfree Laboratory's innovative design for HEPA filter housings allows the HEPA supply filter and the primary (and secondary) exhaust HEPA filters to be scan-tested individually while mounted in the filter housing. This in-situ testing verifies that the filter's gaskets are also leak free. The filter housings are leak tested using a pressure decay test (AGS-G00I-2007), rate of rise test and a helium leak test to verify all housings and the Class III BSC meet or exceed all applicable standards.

- Primary inlet and exhaust HEPA filters are rated at 99.99% efficient for particles measuring 0.3μm in¢ (diameter)
  - o Supply inlet HEPA filter is 12"W x 12"D x 3"H
  - o Exhaust outlet HEPA filters are 12"W x 12"Dx 3"H

# **Testing and Support**

- SGB and Filtration systems are fully tested prior to shipping with test data provided in manual.
   Customers may choose to attend the Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT) at their own expense.
  - All Class III BSCs are tested to meet with American Glovebox Society (AGS) Guidelines for construction and testing of Glovebox enclosures (AGS-G00I-2007).
  - o Tests include:
    - Pressure decay test, rate of rise test
    - Helium leak test
    - Electrical safety tests

#### \*\* EXHIBIT A \*\*

#### **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTORS**

Contractor shall procure and maintain for the duration of the contract insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with the performance of the work hereunder by the Contractor, his agents, representatives, employees or subcontractors. The cost of such insurance shall be included in the Contractor's bid.

### A. MINIMUM SCOPE OF INSURANCE

Coverage shall be at least as broad as:

- 1. Insurance Services Office Commercial General Liability "occurrence" coverage form CG 00 01 (current form approved for use in Louisiana). "Claims Made" form is unacceptable.
- Insurance Services Office form number CA 00 01 (current form approved for use in Louisiana). The
  policy shall provide coverage for owned, hired, and non-owned coverage. If an automobile is to be
  utilized in the execution of this contract, and the vendor/contractor does not own a vehicle, then proof of
  hired and non-owned coverage is sufficient.
- Workers' Compensation insurance as required by the Labor Code of the State of Louisiana, including Employers Liability insurance.

#### **B. MINIMUM LIMITS OF INSURANCE**

Contractor shall maintain limits no less than:

- 1. Commercial General Liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage.
- 2. Automobile Liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit per accident, for bodily injury and property damage.
- 3. Workers Compensation and Employers Liability: Workers' Compensation limits as required by the Labor Code of the State of Louisiana and Employers Liability coverage. Exception: Employers liability limit is to be \$1,000,000 when work is to be over water and involves maritime exposure.

#### C. DEDUCTIBLES AND SELF-INSURED RETENTIONS

Any deductibles or self-insured retentions must be declared to and approved by the Agency. The Contractor shall be responsible for all deductibles and self-insured retentions. At the option of the Agency, the Contractor shall procure a bond guaranteeing payment of losses and related investigations, claim administration and defense expenses.

### D. OTHER INSURANCE PROVISIONS

The policies are to contain, or be endorsed to contain, the following provisions:

- 1. General Liability and Automobile Liability Coverages
  - a. The Agency, its officers, officials, employees, Boards and Commissions and volunteers are to be added as "additional insured's" as respects liability arising out of activities performed by or on behalf of the Contractor; products and completed operations of the Contractor, premises owned, occupied or used by the Contractor. The coverage shall contain no special limitations on the scope of protection afforded to the Agency, its officers, officials, employees or volunteers.

- b. The Contractor's insurance shall be primary insurance as respects the Agency, its officers, officials, employees, Boards and Commissions or volunteers. Any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the Agency shall be excess and non-contributory of the Contractor's insurance.
- b. Any failure to comply with reporting provisions of the policy shall not affect coverage provided to the Agency, its officers, officials, employees, Boards and Commissions or volunteers.
- c. The Contractor's insurance shall apply separately to each insured against whom claim is made or suit is brought, except with respect to the limits of the insurer's liability.

#### 2. Workers' Compensation and Employers Liability Coverage

The insurer shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the Agency, its officers, officials, employees and volunteers for losses arising from work performed by the Contractor for the Agency.

#### 3. All Coverages

Each insurance policy required by this clause shall be endorsed to state that coverage shall not be suspended, voided, canceled by either party, or reduced in coverage or in limits except after thirty (30) days' prior written notice has been given to the Agency.

### E. ACCEPTABILITY OF INSURERS

Insurance is to be placed with insurers with a Best's rating of **A-:VI or higher**. This rating requirement may be waived for workers' compensation coverage only.

#### F. VERIFICATION OF COVERAGE

Contractor shall furnish the Agency with certificates of insurance affecting coverage required by this clause. The certificates for each insurance policy are to be signed by a person authorized by that insurer to bind coverage on its behalf. The certificates are to be received and approved by the Agency before work commences. The Agency reserves the right to require complete, certified copies of all required insurance policies, at any time.

#### G. SUBCONTRACTORS

Contractor shall include all subcontractors as insured's under its policies <u>OR</u> shall furnish separate certificates for each subcontractor. All coverages for subcontractors shall be subject to all of the requirements stated herein.
