Negative Pressure Wound Therapy (NPWT) devices are needed to promote wound healing by delivering negative pressure (a vacuum) to the wound through a dressing and therapy unit creating an environment that promotes the wound healing process (provides a moist wound healing environment, draws wound edges together, removes fluid and infectious materials, reduces wound odor, and reduces the need for daily dressing changes).

Indicated for patients with a variety of chronic, acute, traumatic and dehisced wounds, partial-thickness burns, ulcers (such as diabetic, venous leg, or pressure), and flaps and grafts.
