GENERAL INFORMATION:

Clarifications:

Pertaining to Boardwalk Installation - In addition to standard boardwalk framing as shown on detail sheet L5.4, cross bracing will be supplied and is to be installed per attached manufacturer details for boardwalk sections where the walking surface greater than 30" above grade. There are a total of 63 bracing sets to be included in the installation package. Actual site conditions may warrant small adjustments in total quantity. See attached "Pan Foot Bracing" detail for more information.

Changes to the Drawings:

Sheet L1.0: Revise callout – EXISTING STEEL GRATE RAMP (TO BE REMOVED)

Sheet L5.2: Revise details "A1, A2, & A3 – Kayak Landing" as shown.

Sheet L5.4: Under "Notes" remove the sentence "CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH AND INSTALL HANDRAIL AND CURBING AS SHOWN ON BOARDWALK PLANS." and replace with "HANDRAIL AND CURBING MATERIALS ARE PROVIDED AS PART OF THE BOARDWALK SYSTEM PACKAGE. HORIZONTAL RAILS AND CABLING ARE

Question 1: Are installation instructions available for the pre-purchased products?

- Question 2: When should we expect Notice to Proceed following the bid opening?
- Answer 2: Typically, the contractor can expect Notice to Proceed within 45 days after the award to the qualified low bidder.
- Question 3: What is the anticipated delivery schedule for pre-purchased products?
- Answer 3: The earliest delivery date for boardwalk and restroom packages is estimated at 20-24 weeks from the current date. The installation of each product is estimated to be 4-6 weeks.
- Question 4: Will the contractor be responsible for offloading pre-purchased products? If so, what equipment is needed?




Answer 4: The contractor is responsible for offloading products at the delivery site. Products are delivered on a flatbed truck or trailer and palletized for offloading by forklift. It is recommended that equipment have a 5,000lb lift capacity and fork extensions for boardwalk pallets.

PROJECT SITE: 25.78 ACRES

WORK AREA: 2.00 ACRES (APPROXIMATE)
LIMITED TO EXISTING MAINTAINED OPEN SPACE AREAS AND AREAS OF PROPOSED
IMPROVEMENTS. LIMIT OF WORK EXTENDS APPROXIMATELY 3' BEYOND EDGE OF
PATHS AND STRUCTURES. NO HEAVY MACHINERY OR MATERIAL STORAGE ALLOWED
OUTSIDE OF WORK AREA. LIMIT FOOT TRAFFIC OUTSIDE OF WORK AREA. WORK AREA
SHOWN AS SHADED AREA ON PLAN.

CONSTRUCTION ACCESS: CONSTRUCTION ACCESS RIGHT OF WAY SHALL USE EXISTING MAINTENANCE ACCESS ROUTE FROM BOAT LAUNCH PARKING AREA. COORDINATE WITH ST. TAMMANY PARISH FOR USE OF EXISTING PARKING AREA.

WETLAND: THIS SITE CONTAINS WETLANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS. WETLAND BOUNDARY SHOWN IS BASED ON WETLAND DELINEATION FIELD REPORT AND APPROVED JURISDICTIONAL DETERMINATION NO. MVN-2022-00985-SK. SCOPE OF WORK IN WETLAND AREA LIMITED TO BOARDWALK ONLY. SCOPE OF WORK IN WETLAND AREA LIMITED TO BOARDWALK ONLY.

EXCAVATION: WALKWAYS AND TRAILS SHALL CLOSELY FOLLOW NATURAL GRADE. EXCAVATION LIMITED TO STRIPPING VEGETATION DOWN TO BARE EARTH NOT TO EXCEED 1' BEYOND EDGE OF PATH. NO REMOVAL OF TREES LARGER THAN 2" CALIPER WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL FROM LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT.

DEMOLITION NOTES

- LOCATE ALL UTILITIES ON SITE PRIOR TO COMMENCING WORK. CONTACT LOUISIANA ONE CALL AND APPLICABLE LOCAL UTILITIES COMPANIES FOR MARKING.
- 2. TURF, WEEDS, SHRUBS, TREES OR EXISTING VEGETATION NOTED ON PLAN FOR DEMOLITION ARE TO BE REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF AS PER PARISH CODES, REGULATIONS AND / OR ORDINANCES. WHERE POSSIBLE, CONTRACTOR SHALL CHIP/SHRED REMOVED WOODY MATERIAL AND STORE ON-SITE FOR USE AS NATURAL MULCH FOR DISTURBED AREAS.
- 3. ALL EXISTING ITEMS SUCH AS SITE FURNISHINGS INCLUDING BENCHES, BLEACHERS, AND PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT, SIGNAGE, ETC., UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED, ARE TO BE LEFT IN PLACE OR COORDINATED WITH OWNER FOR STORAGE AND REUSE.
- 4. CONTRACTOR SHALL RECYCLE ALL MATERIALS FROM EXCAVATED AND DEMOLISHED FEATURES WHEN POSSIBLE.
- 5. CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE ALL NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS TO PROTECT EXISTING TREES ON SITE THAT ARE NOT SCHEDULED FOR DEMOLITION FROM CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT PARK VEHICLES OR EQUIPMENT OR STOCKPILE MATERIALS UNDER THE DRIP LINE OF EXISTING TREES.
- 6. VERIFY TREES TO BE REMOVED WITH LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT. TOTAL NUMBER MAY VARY PENDING CONTRACTOR STAKE OUT, AND ACTUAL SITE CONDITIONS.

 CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE TREES FROM PREMISES. REMOVE STUMP OR GRIND ALL STUMPS BELOW GRADE. IF GROUND, REMOVE GROUND WOOD CHIPS AND BACKFILL WITH COMMON FILL.
- 7. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO ON SITE UTILITIES, STRUCTURES OR PAVING RESULTING FROM DEMOLITION OR CONSTRUCTION, AND IS TO REPAIR ANY DAMAGE WHICH OCCURS AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO OWNER.
- 8. ALL WORK, ADJUSTMENTS AND INSPECTIONS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE OWNER.
- 9. CONTRACTOR SHALL PERFORM WORK WITH MINIMAL IMPACT TO TREES, NATURAL DRAINAGE, AND VEGETATION OUTSIDE OF THE WORK AREA.
- 10. "TYPICAL" AND/OR "TYP." MEANS IDENTICAL FOR ALL CONDITIONS MATCHING THE ORIGINAL DETAIL.






