- Q: Due to the limited number of timber piles in this project, would it be acceptable to vibrate in the piles? This would significantly reduce installation costs.
- A: Badeaux Engineers Response: Pile installation should be bid as specified. Installation by vibration would require a geotechnical evaluation. If desired, an evaluation could be performed after the bid so that the associated credit could be reviewed along with any added costs due to potential lower pile capacities, increased pile lengths, etc.
- Q: I'm trying to reach out to someone with Nicholls. There are several questions that fall into play with being able to quote. Will they be removing the old meter / relocating the meter or will this be a new service? Are they wanting a larger size meter? Hopefully they can provide some insight or if you know these answers would be helpful.
- A: WHLC Response: Per note on sheet C-4 Utility Plan, the new water meter, service line, and main line tap are to be installed by the City of Thibodaux. The size of the new meter is to be determined by the City. The contractor/plumber is responsible for all plumbing infrastructure from the water meter to fixtures.
