Attachment C –Delivery Specifications for Cyanotoxin Testing Kits

All bottles and vials must be pre-cleaned before addition of preservative (if any) and sealed by appropriate means. Vendor shall provide the sample bottles with any preservatives based on analytical method requirements. Vendor must ship sample bottles with any preservatives to LDH via next business day delivery. Vendor is responsible for returning/shipping all sample coolers received for this contract to the originator within 7 days of receipt. Vendor is responsible for all shipping costs associated with the return shipment of sample coolers to LDH-SDWP (or designee). Vendor must ship FOB Destination. All shipping costs must be incorporated into the bid for each line item. The Louisiana Department of Health will not approve additional costs for shipping, handling, surcharges, or any other charge associated with shipping of sample supplies and coolers.

Must provide shipments as requested to the Engineering Services Central Office for water testing purposes. LDH reserves the right to add or delete Delivery Addresses as needed.
