- 1. This bid is for supplying industrial and medical gases to LSU Health Sciences Center in Shreveport.
- 2. Payment for gas and any additional charges will be made monthly based on that month's usage or however determined by the customer/lab and the vendor supplying the gas(es) requested. All tracking of cylinders will be the responsibility of the lab and vendor.
- 3. For billing purposes, the successful vendor will establish a new account for each lab at Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center in Shreveport for all charges associated with this contract, keeping all past or outstanding invoices separate.
- 4. Monthly Cylinder Rental invoices sent to the LSU Health Sciences Center for cylinder rental payments must show on the invoice number for any cylinders received or returned during that billing cycle period (month).
- 5. QUALITY: The quality of oxygen and other medical gases shall conform to specifications for hospital therapeutic use and must meet the standard U.S.P. or N.F. requirements for purity. The gases shall not contain any toxic impurities.
- 6. PRICES: All prices are to be firm for the contractual period, but whenever there is a general reduction in price which is lower than the contract price, said reduction must be presented directly to the Health Sciences Center. Prices offered for cylinder oxygen and medical gases must be a flat amount per 100 cubic feet or per cylinder. Sliding scale bids are NOT acceptable and will NOT be considered. Unless otherwise specified, prices requested are for the contents only and do not include price for the purchase of cylinders or rental. Rental and purchase costs are to be quoted where indicated.
 - CYLINDERS AND VALVES: All Cylinders and valves furnished under this contract shall be standard for therapy, industrial and medical uses as prescribed by the Department of Transportation (formerly identified as I.C.C. specifications) cylinder Specifications and Regulations (Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 170-189). All cylinders shall be manufactured, maintained, tested, and filled in accordance with D.O.T. regulations and shall be complete with all fittings, valves, and caps in good working order. All medical and therapy cylinders shall be clean and neat and properly labeled to indicate the nature and amount of contents. All medical valves shall be pin-indexed according to the Compressed Gas Association Standards, and valve outlets shall be sealed to prevent collection of dust and other foreign matter. 8. AVAILABILITY: Vendors should keep on hand a supply of standard and frequently used gases, to enable requests to be filled promptly. Should vendors fail to respond to our needs in a timely manner, the Health Sciences Center reserves the right to withdraw such items from the contract, as vendor has been unable to supply, and award to the next low bidder. The contract may be cancelled by the Health Sciences Center, upon 30 days written notice to vendor for unsatisfactory performance.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTORS

Contractor shall procure and maintain for the duration of the contract insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with the performance of the work hereunder by the Contractor, his agents, representatives, employees or subcontractors. The cost of such insurance shall be included in the Contractor's bid.

A. MINIMUM SCOPE OF INSURANCE

Coverage shall be at least as broad as:

- 1. Insurance Services Office Commercial General Liability "occurrence" coverage form CG 00 01 (current form approved for use in Louisiana). "Claims Made" form is unacceptable.
- Insurance Services Office form number CA 00 01 (current form approved for use in Louisiana). The
 policy shall provide coverage for owned, hired, and non-owned coverage. If an automobile is to be
 utilized in the execution of this contract, and the vendor/contractor does not own a vehicle, then proof of
 hired and non-owned coverage is sufficient.
- 3. Workers' Compensation insurance as required by the Labor Code of the State of Louisiana, including Employers Liability insurance.

B. MINIMUM LIMITS OF INSURANCE

Contractor shall maintain limits no less than:

- 1. Commercial General Liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage.
- 2. Automobile Liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit per accident, for bodily injury and property damage.
- 3. Workers Compensation and Employers Liability: Workers' Compensation limits as required by the Labor Code of the State of Louisiana and Employers Liability coverage. Exception: Employers liability limit is to be \$1,000,000 when work is to be over water and involves maritime exposure.

C. <u>DEDUCTIBLES AND SELF-INSURED RETENTIONS</u>

Any deductibles or self-insured retentions must be declared to and approved by the Agency. The Contractor shall be responsible for all deductibles and self-insured retentions. At the option of the Agency, the Contractor shall procure a bond guaranteeing payment of losses and related investigations, claim administration and defense expenses.

D. OTHER INSURANCE PROVISIONS

The policies are to contain, or be endorsed to contain, the following provisions:

- 1. General Liability and Automobile Liability Coverages
 - a. The Agency, its officers, officials, employees, Boards and Commissions and volunteers are to be added as "additional insured's" as respects liability arising out of activities performed by or on behalf of the Contractor; products and completed operations of the Contractor, premises owned, occupied or used by the Contractor. The coverage shall contain no special limitations on the scope of protection afforded to the Agency, its officers, officials, employees or volunteers.

- b. The Contractor's insurance shall be primary insurance as respects the Agency, its officers, officials, employees, Boards and Commissions or volunteers. Any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the Agency shall be excess and non-contributory of the Contractor's insurance.
- b. Any failure to comply with reporting provisions of the policy shall not affect coverage provided to the Agency, its officers, officials, employees, Boards and Commissions or volunteers.
- c. The Contractor's insurance shall apply separately to each insured against whom claim is made or suit is brought, except with respect to the limits of the insurer's liability.

2. Workers' Compensation and Employers Liability Coverage

The insurer shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the Agency, its officers, officials, employees and volunteers for losses arising from work performed by the Contractor for the Agency.

3. All Coverages

Each insurance policy required by this clause shall be endorsed to state that coverage shall not be suspended, voided, canceled by either party, or reduced in coverage or in limits except after thirty (30) days' prior written notice has been given to the Agency.

E. ACCEPTABILITY OF INSURERS

Insurance is to be placed with insurers with a Best's rating of **A-:VI or higher**. This rating requirement may be waived for workers' compensation coverage only.

F. VERIFICATION OF COVERAGE

Contractor shall furnish the Agency with certificates of insurance affecting coverage required by this clause. The certificates for each insurance policy are to be signed by a person authorized by that insurer to bind coverage on its behalf. The certificates are to be received and approved by the Agency before work commences. The Agency reserves the right to require complete, certified copies of all required insurance policies, at any time.

G. SUBCONTRACTORS

Contractor shall include all subcontractors as insured's under its policies <u>OR</u> shall furnish separate certificates for each subcontractor. All coverages for subcontractors shall be subject to all of the requirements stated herein.
