## **ADDENDUM #1**

September 5, 2025

RE: Sealed Bid Number 50012-627-26: Purchase of Video-Audio Monitoring and Recording of Therapy Sessions

The following information is provided to amend the original invitation to bid on August 12, 2025.

- The original invitation to bid indicated that the Speech and Hearing Clinic utilizes eleven (11) therapy / observation rooms in Robinson Hall. This information is hereby amended to indicate that the Speech and Hearing Clinic utilizes twelve (12) therapy/observations rooms in Robinson Hall.
- The original invitation to bid indicated that the system bid by vendors must include eleven (11) ceiling-mounted cameras and eleven (11) external microphones. The information is hereby amended to indicate that the system bid by vendors must include twelve (12) ceiling-mounted cameras and twelve (12) external microphones.
- The original invitation to bid did not specifically identify which room numbers in which the cameras / external microphones are to installed. This information is hereby added to include the room numbers which the cameras are to be installed; the first floor lab and rooms # 131, 130, 129, 128, 127, 126, 125, 124, 123, 122, and 113. As additional information, a PDF layout of the first floor of Robinson Hall is attached to this addendum.
- In response to a question from a vendor, this solicitation will not require the issuance of a payment and performance bond by the awarded vendor.
- As a clarification of the optional wireless intercom / monitoring system that is a part of this solicitation. This is optional ONLY. This wireless intercom system will allow University Faculty and Staff that supervise and instruct in the Speech and Hearing Clinic to communicate with student clinicians as they (the student clinicians) are conducting therapy sessions. This communication does not need to be recorded or even connected to the Video-Audio Monitoring and Recording system that is being bid. Vendors are free to propose a solution that they feel will work simply and reliably. This wireless intercom system should not be distracting to the patient, nor should communication from the Faculty/Staff member to the student clinical be heard by the patient. It is also not necessary for the student clinician to be able to communicate back to the faculty/staff member. One-way communication is permissible. The Fac/Staff will communicate with one student clinician at a time, with the possibility of up to eight simutaneous Fac/Staff Student Clinician pairs working. Low-profile headsets and / or earpieces are acceptable.

## All other specifications remain unchanged.


