Your reference is directed to RFx Number 3000025325 for the Invitation to Bid (ITB) for the State of Louisiana –Starlink Satellite Equip and Svc - SW, which is currently scheduled to open at 10:00 AM CT on 10/21/25.

Attachment B – Price Sheet, Page 1 has been replaced in its entirety. See REVISED Attachment B - Price Sheet (Revised per Addendum NO. 02 dated 10/09/2025).

The following language has been added to Attachment A – Special Terms and Conditions:

Price Escalation:

This contract price shall remain firm and effective for the duration of the initial contract period. Price adjustments will be considered for subsequent annual contract renewals. Price adjustments shall only be permitted for changes in the Contractor's cost of materials or services. The Contractor must submit a written request for price adjustments, accompanied by documentation justifying the request, to the Office of State Procurement at least 30 days prior to the contract anniversary. No adjustment shall be effective until approved in writing by the Office of State Procurement. The State reserves the right to accept, reject, or negotiate the proposed price adjustment. Orders shall be invoiced at the contract prices in effect on the date of the purchase order.

The Producer Price Index (PPI) series PCU173125173121 Wireless Telecommunications Carriers, published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United States Department of Labor will be used as a guide in reviewing any price adjustments.

The latest performance Starlink available is the Performance Kit (Generation 3), which is replacing the Flat High-Performance Terminal. Would the State of Louisiana like this terminal included as an option?

Could you please confirm if we are able to include the Managed Support Service Fee in the contract? If this is possible, should we add it under the service plans, or would it be possible to provide an amendment including the 24/7 support line in Attachment B?

Vendor's Inquiry #8:

For items 1-7 in Attachment B - Price Sheet, will the State accept an annual unit of measure instead of monthly?

State's Response #8:

The service plans for this solicitation are being bid out as monthly. Yearly subscriptions will not be included in this solicitation.

Vendor's Inquiry #9:

Will the State permit inclusion of the full Starlink product catalog, including additional kits and accessory equipment?

State's Response #9:

Vendor's Inquiry #10:

Regarding the products listed in Attachment B, is the State Louisiana aware of upcoming Starlink equipment end-of-life (EOL), and do you intend to include EOL items in the bid?

State's Response #10:

Vendor's Inquiry #11:

How many Starlink units are currently deployed by the State?

State's Response #11:

Vendor's Inquiry #12:

What is the intended use case for the Global Priority Plans noted in the description of items 5-7 in Attachment B - Price Sheet?

State's Response #12:

Please see the Revised Attachment B – Price Sheet.

Vendor's Inquiry #13:

Is the State informed of the differences between residential and enterprise Starlink plans and kits?

State's Response #13:

The State cannot provide this information at this time.

Vendor's Inquiry #14:

Is the State open to competitive bidding for installation and support services?

State's Response #14:

Installation services will not be included in this solicitation. Please see the Revised Attachment B – Price Sheet regarding the support services.

Vendor's Inquiry #15:

Concerning Item 9 in Attachment B, can the State please clarify which product is being requested: High Performance Flat (End of Life) or High Performance (officially named "Performance Kit")?

State's Response #15:

Please see the Revised Attachment B – Price Sheet.

Vendor's Inquiry #16:

Given that Starlink's services are subject to non-negotiable terms and conditions that must be passed through to customers, will the State accept the bidder's service schedule containing the mandatory Starlink terms?

State's Response #16:

Per Attachment A – Special Terms and Conditions, Page 3, Terms and Conditions, any vendor contracts, forms, terms, or other materials submitted with the bid may cause the bid to be rejected.

Vendor's Inquiry #17:

If Starlink's mandatory terms conflict with or are inconsistent with the ITB terms, may the bidder take exception to those conflicting ITB terms in order to align with Starlink's requirements? For example, Starlink does not permit termination for convenience, while the Instructions to Bidders include a termination for convenience right for the State in Section 22 (Contract Cancellation").

State's Response #17:

Vendor's Inquiry #18:

The ITB does not include a limitation of liability provision. Will the State consider adding language that excludes indirect damages and establishes a mutually acceptable cap on liability?

State's Response #18:

All specifications in the ITB will remain as written.

Vendor's Inquiry #19:

If the Instructions to Bidders and the Special Terms and Conditions address the same topic, but are not in direct conflict with each other, will only the Special Terms and Conditions apply, or will both provisions be read together? For example, both documents address termination rights differently but do not directly conflict.

State's Response #19:

See Instructions to Bidders, #24 Order of Priority section on page 6 of the RFx.

Vendor's Inquiry #20:

If the Instructions to Bidders includes a provision that is not addressed in the Special Terms and Conditions, does the Instructions to Bidders provision apply, or does the absence of the term in the Special Terms and Conditions mean it is excluded? For example, indemnity is addressed only in the Instructions to Bidders and not in the Special Terms and Conditions.

Please clarify whether the State expects respondents to:

- a. Include installation services and associated costs as part of the proposal response,
- b. Assume that installation will be coordinated and funded separately by the State?

Vendor's Inquiry #22:

For statewide deployments, will the State require bidders to demonstrate program management capabilities, including multi-site coordination, reporting, and invoicing at scale?

Will the State require bidders to confirm their ability to deliver Starlink equipment at scale within specified timeframes, considering current lead times and supply chain limitations?

State's Response #22:

Refer to Attachment A – Special Terms and Conditions, page 5, Delivery. All requirements for bidders are outlined in the solicitation.

Vendor's Inquiry #23:

Can the state provide a list of currently used Starlink Services and estimated quantities associated with this ITB?

Vendor's Inquiry #24:

With the understanding that the Starlink Local Priority Plans cover the Entire US as part of the Plan, while Global Priority Plans are designed for use outside of the United States, and knowing that the State of LA and Government customers typically require US Only coverage, does the state require the Starlink Global Priority service plans listed on the pricing document? Will the State consider making an award for Starlink Local Priority Service Plans only, if a vendor only provides US based product for Government customers?

Please confirm all pricing should be inclusive of Taxes, fees, and surcharges?
