QUESTIONS & ANSWERS:

Question 1. The LightGuard specified system requires Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) and Remote Activation Detectors to be wired back to the control panel. There is currently no pay item provided for roadway removal or boring required to install this wiring. Addendum 1 indicates that this cost is to be included under Reference No. 3; however, performing this work will require a flagging operation, as the majority of the roadways do not have usable shoulders. Can you please clarify the MOT restrictions and allowable timeframes for performing this work?

Answer 1. All traffic control and flagging operations, lane closures, and associated work necessary to complete the installation of the LightGuard Systems or equal shall be the responsibility of the contractor and shall be included in the bid price.

Question 2. Regarding the Remote Activation Detectors: these are required to be mounted on a pole within the bike lane, within 5 feet of the crosswalk and 2 feet outside of it. Should these detectors and associated mounting infrastructure be included under Reference No. 3 – Installation of LightGuard Systems (or equal)?

Answer 2. All components required for a complete and fully functional flashing beacon system including Remote Activation Detectors, mounting hardware, wiring, communications equipment, and associated infrastructure required by the manufacturer's system design shall be included under Ref 3.



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Question 3. It is our understanding that this component may vary by system and could warrant a separate pay item.

Answer 3. No separate pay items will be provided for these components.

Question 4. Given the level of uncertainty surrounding the scope and installation requirements, we believe it would be beneficial to postpone the bid and hold a mandatory pre-bid meeting. This would help ensure that the requirements from St. Tammany Parish are clearly defined, consistent, and achievable for all bidders

Answer 4. At this time the bid/quote opening date will remain unchanged and will not be rescheduled.

Question 5. Is st tammany parish government providing new poles and concrete fondations for new poles required?

Answer 5. Yes
