Waste Management Services

This Addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original Invitation for Bids (IFB). All provisions not specifically modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.

Question 1:

How often are the front-load dumpsters serviced?

Response:

Please refer to Page 30 of the IFB and Addendum No. 1 for the required service frequencies for all front-load dumpsters.

Question 2:

Is the compactor serviced on a set schedule or on an "as-needed" basis? Can the University provide the service schedule or average number of hauls per month?

Response:

The compactor shall be serviced once per week, with dumping and return service occurring every Friday. Maintenance schedules shall be determined by the Contractor as necessary to ensure proper operation of the equipment.

Question 3:

What size roll-off containers are required for move-in, move-out, football games, and other special events?

Response:

The University requires a standard twenty (20) cubic yard roll-off container for all scheduled events. Should larger containers be required, the University will request those services on an as-needed basis.

Please also refer to Page 25 of the IFB and Addendum No. 1 regarding event-related waste collection requirements.

Question 4:

Can the University provide a copy of the current contract and a recent invoice?

Response:

Current contract and invoice information will not be provided. Bidders should prepare and submit pricing based on the specifications and requirements outlined in the IFB and Addenda.

Question 5:

Are the two (2) companies that attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting the only vendors eligible to submit a bid?

Response:

No, As stated on Page 7 of the IFB, attendance was not mandatory pre-bid conference was required. Only vendors represented at the mandatory pre-bid conference are eligible to submit a bid.

Question 6:

Can the University provide historical annual tonnage records for the compactor and roll-off containers?

Response:

Historical annual tonnage records are not available.

Question 7:

Can the University provide average tons per pull for the compactor and roll-off services?

Response:

This information is not available.

Question 8:

May bidders structure pricing using a haul/pull charge plus disposal charges based on actual landfill tonnage?

Response:

Yes. Bidders may provide haul/pull pricing separately from landfill disposal fees where indicated on the pricing sheet. Disposal fees shall be based on actual tonnage.

Question 9:

For Roll-Off Haul/Pull Charges and Additional Compactor Pulls, are landfill disposal/tipping fees included in the bid price, or will disposal be billed separately based on actual tonnage?

Response:

Landfill disposal and tipping fees shall be billed separately based on actual tonnage.
