Questions & Answers

Q1: As a Louisiana certified Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) and a registered state vendor will special preference be given to my company during the bid process?

A1: No preference will be given

Q2: If my SDVOSB company is working with a company that is submitting a bid proposal will any special consideration be given?

A2: This contract does not acknowledge special consideration of any kind

Q3: Are we required to bid all items listed in the bid package or can we select categories to bid?

A3: To be considered for award, all items in a group must be bid. The City Parish specifically reserves the right to evaluate bids and award items separately, grouped or on an all or none basis, to accept the bid which is in the best interest of the City parish, and to reject all proposals if that is in the best interest of the City Parish.

Q4: Do I need to register with the EBRP as a registered vendor?

A4: You do not need to registered with EBRP to bid; you will be required to be registered if you are awarded the contract.
