We are seeking a rate improvement on the existing plan, ideally, but will consider a leaner plan design in order to achieve cost savings.</p>

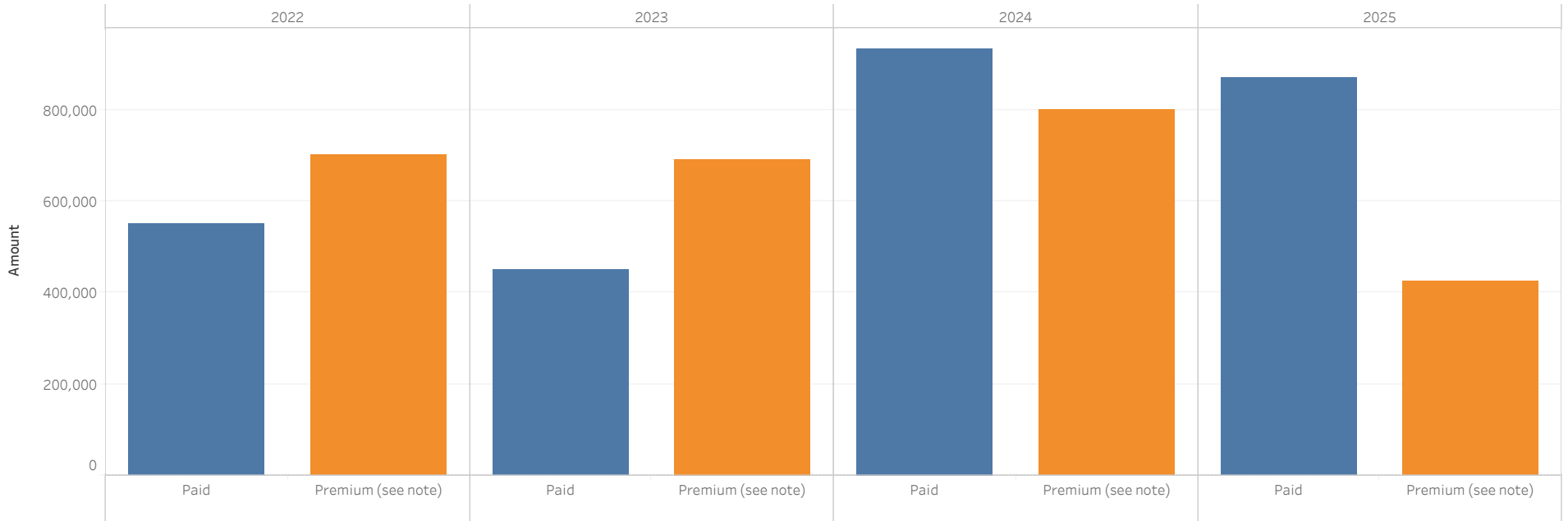
