In regards to questions 1 through 3 below:

The legal ad / notice to proposers for the RFQ stated:

“A mandatory prebid conference will be held on July 8, 2026 at 2:00 pm CST at 222 St. Louis Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70802 (City Hall Building, Room 826). Only companies represented at the prebid conference shall be considered for award.”

Q1. Does failure to attend the July 8 mandatory preproposal conference automatically disqualifies our submission?

A1. Any vendor not present at the mandatory prebid conference would automatically be disqualified

Q2 Is any alternative attendance documentation, waiver, additional meeting, recording, or corrective procedure is available?

A2. No waiver or corrective procedure is available for any vendor who did not attend the mandatory prebid conference

Q3. Would the City-Parish still accept and evaluate our qualifications submission?

A3. The City will not accept or evaluate any qualifications submission from any vendor who did not attend the mandatory prebid conference

Q4. Wanted to reach out as we ran into a snag for our application with this RFQ. We do not hold a Board meeting until August and therefore will not be able to put together a Corporate Resolution. (We take the month of July off with our Board) Please advise how to proceed.
